



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

Grand Asian University, Sialkot

And

Medical Devices (Pvt) Limited, Sialkot

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (hereinafter referred to as "MOU") is made and entered into on the 15th day of April 2026.

BETWEEN

Grand Asian University Sialkot (GAUS) is a chartered university by the Government of Punjab located at a very strategic location in the golden triangle. The golden triangle (Gujranwala, Sialkot, and Gujrat) consists of three industrial cities in Pakistan that contribute 15% of export and are a hub of innovation and creativity. The university aims to impart quality education, uplift the life of quality of people in the surroundings, and contribute to the growth of the local industry. GAUS has a permanent address as GAUS 07 KM, Pasrur Road, Sialkot, Punjab (**hereinafter referred to as "GAUS"**) of the one part;

AND

Medical Devices (Pvt.) Limited (Hereinafter referred to as "MD") that was established in 1991 in Sialkot situated at Main Wazirabad Road, Ugoki, Sialkot Pakistan. It is engaged in manufacturing and production of high quality of Medical Devices.

GAUS and **MD** shall be collectively referred to as "**the Parties**" and individually as "**the Party**". The parties agree that the main objective of this MOU is as follows: -

- GAUS will provide scholarship/ fee discount upto 30% to the employees and Childrens of the employees of the MD / Medical Devices (Pvt.) Ltd.
- GAUS will provide the professional development trainings (in-house and external/ outsourced) to the employees of the MD / Medical Devices (Pvt.) Ltd. through its Professional Development Center (PDC) on the latest trends of Soft and Technical Skills on subsedised rates.
- Medical Devices (Pvt.) Ltd. will provide scholarship support of Rs. 500,000 per year for admissions under the title "**MD Scholarship.**"This scholarship is limited to the financing of admission fee, tuition fee, exam fee, library and lab fees of the concerned student(s). This financing is subject to good performance by the student(s). If the student(s) does not achieve and maintain average results of 80%, the scholarship shall be withdrawn for the concerned student(s). The concerned student(s) is also responsible to achieve and maintain high level of moral values. The scholarship shall be withdrawn if the concerned student(s) found guilty or/and misconduct of moral values.
- MD / Medical Devices (Pvt.) Ltd. will provide internship and job oppportunities for students of GAUS subject to availability of placements.
- MD / Medical Devices (Pvt.) Ltd. will provide industrial visit opportunity for GAUS students and faculty.
- Medical Devices (Pvt.) Ltd. may support or fund the Final Year Projects (FYPs) of engineering students, in line with the requirements of the Pakistan Engineering Council. The company will review each FYP proposal and decide

on support or funding accordingly. Preference will be given to projects that are relevant to the company's product lines or operational needs. Both parties will undertake and collaborate in joint research & development projects, seminars, conferences on sustainability issues under their Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) programs.

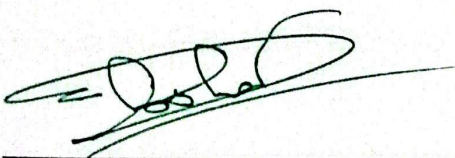
- Both parties will collectively engage in Industry-driven curriculum design of Business Administration and Engineering & Technology programs.

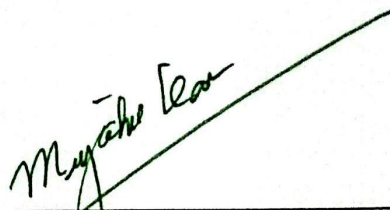

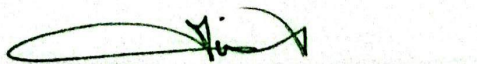
