



## **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

**Between**

**Grand Asian University, Sialkot**

**And**

**Premier Waste Management. Pvt Ltd**

**THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING** (hereinafter referred to as the "MoU") is made and entered into on the 15 day of May, 2025.

**BETWEEN**

**Grand Asian University, Sialkot (GAUS)** is a chartered university established by the Government of Punjab, located on Pasrur Road, Sialkot, Punjab, Pakistan. Situated in the strategic industrial corridor of the Gujranwala–Sialkot–Gujrat region, the University is committed to providing quality education, promoting research and innovation, fostering community engagement, and advancing sustainable development through academic excellence and institutional partnerships. GAUS has its permanent address at 7 KM, Pasrur Road, Sialkot, Punjab, Pakistan (hereinafter referred to as "**GAUS**") of the one part;

**AND**

**Premier Waste Management (PWM)** situated at Shah Jilani Road, Block 2, Sector D-1, Township Lahore is a specialized, private waste disposal company, accredited by the EPA Punjab. They provide end-to-end services ranging from collection and transportation to scientific disposal and recycling of hazardous, non-hazardous, and hospital infectious waste. (hereinafter referred to as "**PWM**") of the other part.

GAUS and PWM shall collectively be referred to as "**the Parties**" and individually as "**the Party**."

The Parties agree that the main objectives of this MoU are as follows:

- PWM shall provide technical guidance and advisory support for sustainable municipal solid waste management, including waste segregation, recycling, resource recovery, and environmentally responsible disposal practices within the University.
- PWM shall facilitate the scheduled collection, transportation, recycling, treatment, and disposal of non-hazardous municipal solid waste generated at designated locations across the GAUS campus in accordance with applicable environmental laws and regulations.
- GAUS shall establish and maintain designated waste segregation and collection points and promote sustainable waste management practices among students, faculty, staff, and visitors.
- Both Parties shall jointly promote waste minimization, recycling initiatives, circular economy practices, and responsible resource utilization across the University.
- Both Parties shall organize environmental awareness campaigns, sustainability seminars, workshops, training programs, World Environment Day activities, plantation drives, and community outreach initiatives to promote environmental stewardship and sustainable development.
- PWM shall facilitate educational visits, internships, technical demonstrations, and student engagement opportunities related to waste management, environmental protection, and sustainability.
- The Parties shall collaborate in research, innovation, environmental monitoring projects, and entrepreneurship initiatives related to sustainable waste management and environmental conservation.
- PWM shall, where available, provide periodic waste management data and reports to support GAUS sustainability reporting, environmental performance

assessment, and documentation for national and international sustainability rankings, including the UI GreenMetric World University Rankings.

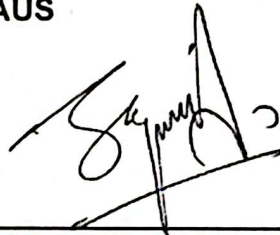
- Both Parties shall cooperate in advancing initiatives aligned with the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), particularly SDG 11 (Sustainable Cities and Communities), SDG 12 (Responsible Consumption and Production), SDG 13 (Climate Action), SDG 15 (Life on Land), and SDG 17 (Partnerships for the Goals).
- This MoU shall serve as a non-financial framework for cooperation and shall not create any financial obligation upon either Party unless separately agreed in writing.
- Neither Party shall be held liable for failure to perform its obligations due to circumstances beyond its reasonable control, including natural disasters, pandemics, governmental actions, strikes, war, or other force majeure events.
- The Parties may amend any provision of this MoU through mutual written consent.
- This MoU shall remain valid for a period of **three (03) years** from the date of signing and may be renewed by mutual written agreement.
- Either Party may terminate this MoU by providing **one month's prior written notice** to the other Party.
