



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

Grand Asian University, Sialkot

And

Isaar Welfare Foundation

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (hereinafter referred to as "MOU") is made and entered into on the **5th day of May 2026**.

BETWEEN

Grand Asian University Sialkot (GAUS) is a chartered university by the Government of Punjab located at a very strategic location in the golden triangle. The golden triangle (Gujranwala, Sialkot, and Gujrat) consists of three industrial cities in Pakistan that contribute 15% of export and are a hub of innovation and creativity. The university aims to impart quality education, uplift the life of quality of people in the surroundings, and contribute to the growth of the local industry. GAUS has a permanent address as GAUS 07 KM, Pasrur Road, Sialkot, Punjab (**hereinafter referred to as "GAUS"**) of the one part;

AND

ISAAR WELFARE FOUNDATION (Hereinafter referred to as "IWF") that was established in 2019 in Sialkot situated at Abbot Road, Sialkot, Punjab – Pakistan. It is engaged in provision of welfare and certified health services including blood bank operations, community health camps, and humanitarian outreach programs with a dedicated blood bank and health service facility operational year-round. Since its inception, IWF has expanded its operations beyond Sialkot to Daska, Sambrial, and Pasrur, extending its humanitarian services and health outreach to a wider population across the region.

GAUS and IWF shall be collectively referred to as "**the Parties**" and individually as "**the Party**". The parties agree that the main objective of this MOU is as follows: -

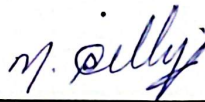
- GAUS will provide scholarship/ fee discount up to 30% to the employees and children of the employees of the IWF.
- GAUS will provide the professional development trainings (in-house and external/ outsourced) to the employees of the IWF through its Professional Development Center (PDC) on the latest trends of Soft and Technical Skills on subsidized rates.
- IWF will provide internship and job opportunities for students of GAUS subject to availability of placements.
- IWF will provide industrial visit opportunity for GAUS students and faculty.
- Isaar Welfare Foundation, shall organize and conduct blood donation camps/drives at GAUS premises utilizing its own certified medical resources and personnel.
- Both Parties shall jointly organize and participate in Environmental Awareness Campaigns and Community Outreach Programs aimed at promoting

sustainable practices, civic engagement, and social development within the institution and the broader community.

- The Parties can amend any clause of this MOU with mutual consultation.

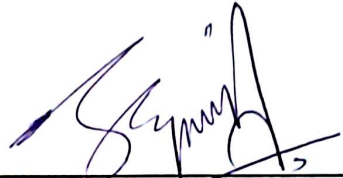
