



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

Grand Asian University, Sialkot

And

Regional Tax Office, Sialkot

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (hereinafter referred to as "MOU") is made and entered into on the 14th, May 2024.

BETWEEN

Grand Asian University Sialkot (GAUS), which is a chartered University by the Government of the Punjab Act, 2021 was passed by the Punjab Assembly on December 20, 2021 and was published in the Punjab Gazette on December 24, 2021 having been assented by the Governor of the Punjab. Consequently, the Higher Education Department notified the establishment of the University in the private sector in terms of section 3(1) of the Act ibid, vide Notification No. SO(Univ.)9-2/2021 dated January 19, 2022. Grand Asian University Sialkot is located at a very strategic location in the golden triangle. The golden triangle (Gujranwala, Sialkot, and Gujrat) consists of three industrial cities in Pakistan that contribute 15% of export and are a hub of innovation and creativity. The University aims to impart quality education, uplift the life of quality of people in the surroundings, and contribute to the growth of the local industry. GAUS has a permanent address as GAUS 07 KM, Pasrur Road, Sialkot, Punjab (hereinafter referred to as "GAUS") of the one part;

AND

Regional Tax Office, Sialkot (RTO). The Regional Tax Office, Sialkot, is a federal law enforcement agency of Pakistan that investigates tax crimes, suspicious accumulation of wealth, money-laundering with main task of collection of taxes i.e. Income Tax, Sales Tax and FED. (Hereinafter referred to as "RTO") of the other part;

GAUS and RTO shall be collectively referred to as "the Parties" and individually as "the Party".

OBJECTIVES: -

The parties agree that the main objective of this MOU is as follows: -

- To promote educational awareness, development of students, and career progression

To realize the said objective, the parties hereby agree and declare as follows:

1. Admissions (GAUS):

SR.	Categories	Description	Proposed Fee Concession (Only on Tuition Fee)
1.	All Officers/ Officials (in service).	Their dependents including siblings/Wards.	40%
2.	All Officers/ Officials (Retired).	Their dependents including siblings/ Wards.	45%

2. COURSE & DEGREE REQUIREMENTS:

- All admitted students of RTO employees and/or their children shall be bound to follow course and degree requirements as prescribed in the prospectus and any issue from time to time by regulatory bodies and/or GAUS.

3. Disciplinary Policy:

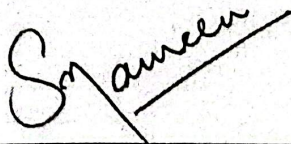
- All admitted students of RTO employees and/or their children shall be bound to follow the discipline policy of the GAUS and any instructions issued from time to time in this regard. In any instance, the decision of the Disciplinary Committee (DC) shall be final and applicable.

4. WITHDRAWAL OF CONCESSION:

- The concession shall be withdrawn from the student in an instance of a serious breach of 3 (course & degree requirements) and 4 (Disciplinary policy) other than the penalties/repercussion of the said Requirement and policies.

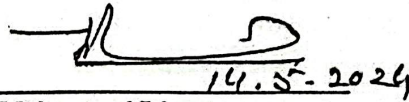
